



Hello CLC Community,

As we explore our options for a safe return to school this year, our staff and pandemic team are proposing to start the year with a 4-day per week in-school schedule where students would attend classes in-school on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. On Wednesdays, students would participate in remote learning classes on a similar schedule to their regular school day.

Note: Wednesdays are remote learning with teachers allowed to teach from home or school. Families may elect for their student to participate in remote learning any school day.

This proposed schedule would provide us with a variety of benefits as we enter the 2020-21 school year. Research models show that avoiding week-long in-school sessions can reduce the spread of the coronavirus. By establishing a midweek remote learning day, our hopes are to more fully sanitize and ventilate our facilities in addition to providing a break for everyone's immune systems. Our Wednesday remote learning days will also serve as effective training for both students and teachers as we work to improve our remote learning program in the event that local conditions force schools to fully transition to remote learning.

Understand that due to the fluid nature of the pandemic, we will continue to reevaluate any plans that we have in place based upon local conditions and new research that is made available to us. If conditions stabilize and improve, we would consider transitioning to in-school learning 5-days a week, while if conditions decline, remote learning may be necessary.
