Thank you for your responses to our 4-day school week proposal. The responses were overwhelmingly positive, and we appreciate those who are committed to make remote learning on Wednesdays work despite some difficulties. On Wednesday, July 22, the CLC Board approved our Health and Safety Plan, which includes the 4-day week proposal. In-school learning will be available on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday of each week, and Wednesdays will be a remote learning day for all students. You may choose in-school or remote learning for your child any school day with Wednesdays being a remote learning day for all students.
